

SPECTATOR'S SHOW HALL ETIQUETTE

(DO'S AND DON'TS)

There are a few things to keep in mind when attending a Cat Show. It will make for a happier experience for you, the cats and the cats' owners.

- **Please be aware of exhibitors carrying cats to and from the judging rings. Move to one side and let them through and if you hear an “excuse me” or “cat coming through” the same applies.**
- **Please do not touch the kitties unless the owner gives permission. Always ask first. Sometimes the answer will be “yes”, but sometimes it will be “no”. If the answer is “yes” the owner of the kitty may ask you to disinfect your hands (with “Purell” or something similar) before you touch it.**
- **Parents, please keep your children with you at all times. Running in the show hall is not allowed as it may upset the cats. As well, someone could be injured.**
- **Children, yelling and screaming is not allowed – mainly because it scares the cats, but it also bothers other people.**
- **Kitties can be viewed in the benching areas (rows) but do not approach the cages in the judging rings. You can watch the judging by taking a seat in front of the judging ring.**
